Ron gave us a sketch of the possible building sites showcasing the Parsonage (next to the cemetery), and the back lot of the Library/Historical Society/Schoolhouse. Each has it's benefits.

Maureen will work up some proposals based on the population of the town (236 registered voters at this time) and based upon Ron's topo maps of the sites. Then we will be able to present this to the towns people for discussion and consideration. Maureen suggested that by placing the municipal building near the parsonage, it would 'complete" the town center. Although the spot behind the library would require less site work.

General consensus of meeting members is that while we love the idea of the building being on the parsonage site, we think it will easier to build at the library site.
