Selectmen's Meeting called to order at 8:00

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the warrant article concerning the Town Hall and the proposed relocation and reconstruction of it.

After further review of the costs associated with the relocation and reconstruction of the Town hall, the selectmen feel that considering the amount of money estimated to complete this project the Town would be better off to not support this project until further estimates are received to possibly build a new building. The Selectmen also felt that it would be wise to discuss and vote on the warrant as written and if the majority of people vote to proceed with the relocation and reconstruction of the Town hall then the selectmen would support that vote and move forward.

If the warrant is voted down the Selectmen would then move to improve the Town hall to comply with the letter the Town received from the State Fire Marshall. The Town currently has enough money in the building fund to accomplish this. The Selectmen would also look at stabilizing the building in place and get estimates for this and if there is currently not enough money in the building fund we would need to come back to the voters at the next Town meeting.

Also if the existing warrant is voted down the Selectmen will look at building a new building and this would be brought forward in a warrant article at the next Town meeting.

Ron was going to research if absentee ballots can be accepted for Town meeting.

Bill Perry was going to try and get estimates for what it would cost for the Town to comply with the requirements outlined in the Fire Marshall's letter of this past August. These numbers will be available to be discussed at Town Meeting.
