The Board signed vouchers.

The Board reviewed and signed the MS-535 & the MS-232.

The Board received the total equalization valuation report from the DRA.

EverSource invited the Board to several meetings being held.

The Board discussed a letter sent to the tax collector by Anne Barber, attorney for Alexis Brochu. The letter indicated that Ms. Brochu should not be sent any mailings regarding taxes. The Town only has Ms. Brochu on record as the owner of the property located in Chatham. Ms. Barber and Ms. Brochu will be notified of this.

The Board discussed the timber cut in South Chatham on WMNF. The DRA will be notified of the lack of an intent to cut.

The Board reviewed a letter written by Wayne Infinger to the State Fire Marshall. Jason suggested adding fire extinguishers to the letter. Bill will forward suggestion to Wayne and the letter will be sent.

The Board discussed the selling of the property located on Province Brook road that was taken by tax deed. The Board made a list of questions to email to the DRA. The Board will discuss the selling of the property at the next meeting.

Jason Eastman updated the Board on progress being made by the Building Committee. The Building Committee has been getting quotes on how much it will cost to build different types of small buildings. Bill Perry reported that he is waiting for a quote from Fox & Sons to replace the sills. He also reported that George Perry had not replaced the window at the Town House but that he would soon. Bill is also going to ask Marc Greeney how much it will cost to clear cut an acre to place a new town building on.

The Board discussed making a policy for town property use. Bill gave Jason a copy of a sample policy. The Board will discuss the policy at the next meeting.

Bill is planning on attending a meeting for municipal officers in Conway on May 15.

The Selectman will plan their annual drive around for early June.

Bill completed the DOT report and asked for it to be mailed back to the DOT.
