The town computer is down- can not connect to the internet. The timber tax program to compute yield tax bills is access through the internet. Board members will have to sign the warrant when the computer connection is repaired.

The Board will do the annual drive around at 7:00 am on June 23<sup>rd</sup>. Jason Eastman will pick up the paperwork.

William Perry attended a conference in May. There was much discussion around the Right to Know Law. It is recommended that town officials not use their personal emails. William Perry will post a new list of future meeting dates for Selectmen's meetings. He will also post agenda's for future meetings a few day prior to each meeting.

Wayne Infinger is going to look into the RSA's pertaining to fireworks. He will have a sign made that will state the RSA that prohibits fireworks from being set off on property that is not owned by the person setting off the fireworks. The Board put a 250 dollar limit on the signage.
