December 5, 2019

Attendance: Jason Eastman, Micah Voter, Tricia Pitman and Bill Briggs

Meeting called to order.

Minutes for November were accepted as written.

Vouchers were signed.

December 16th the generator will be installed. Jason Eastman will contact JA Corey Electric to see if someone needs to be here.

North Country Council sent sample warrants for the Selectmen to put in the town report but the warrant articles did not apply to the Town of Chatham.

The Selectmen received a list of people that were reappointed as Fire Warden Deputies.

The Selectmen received a copy of Carroll County's budget.

The North Conway Water Precinct sent the Selectmen a contract to sign agree that septic waste could be sent to the North Conway Water Precinct Wastewater Treatment Facility. This would be a formality and not necessary to have in place for septic waste to be treated at the facility so the Selectmen declined to sign the agreement at this time.

The Dept. of Environmental Services sent two letters regarding applications for a project that the Saco Ranger District USDA Forest Service is doing.

A current use application was received and approved for property owned by James Coogan and Rebecca Knowles to be placed in current use.

Rod Wood advised the Selectmen that .5 acres of land will need to be removed from current use owned by Justin Fisher.

The Selectmen received a letter from the State of New Hampshire office of Professional Licensure and Certification. The letter was addressed to the Code Enforcement Officer and was concerning installation of manufactured homes.

The Selectmen must set up a meeting between themselves, Tom Henriksen and Rod Wood to possibly come to an agreement about the appeal that was filed by Mr. Henriksen. The Selectmen indicated that meeting after 4:00 would be preferable.

The Selectmen will meet on Tuesday, January 21 at 4:00 to discuss the budget. This will be a workshop meeting.

Jason Eastman will contact David Emery about gaining access to the basement through the town office.

Jason Eastman will contact Suburban Propane to attach the generator with the propane tanks.

The Selectmen will begin to work on a building use policy.

The Selectmen would like to have all of the boxes of documents moved to the basement as soon as possible so that it is not in the town hall on election day in February.

The Selectmen appointed Burt Weiss to represent the town of Chatham on the Carroll County Broad Band Committee.

A motion to adjourn was made and seconded.
