DOT sent approval for a driveway permit for Cassandra Cox.

DOT sent notice that they will be resurfacing part of the road in Chatham.

USDA sent a notification about a decision that they made in regards to the Evans Brook Vegetation Management Project.

NHDES sent approval form for a dredge and fill permit.

DOT paperwork will be updated with current information after town meeting.

Maine Waste Management sent a contract for the Selectmen to consider. The Selectmen opted to go with a 5-year contract.

US Census Bureau sent the maps that went along with the forms that were signed at the last board meeting.

The contract with Rod Wood was signed and will be mailed to him for signatures.

There were no suggestions from the DRA for any changes to be made to the contract.

The generator project will have to wait until spring to be completed.

The Selectmen all agreed to have a member of the Sheriff's Department attend town meeting. Jason will follow up and make sure that they can send someone.

The Selectmen worked on a building use policy. It will be typed up and reviewed at the next meeting.

Road Agent's Report- Alan Eastman ordered signs to post roads. He will call the NH Municipal Association to make sure that there isn't anything that needs to be done prior to posting the roads.

A motion to adjourn was made and seconded.
