The Selectmen went over 2 changes that the budget committee made. The Fire Department request was lowered to 15,512.50 and the Library request was lowered to 700.

The Sales Ratio was at 83.7 %. Rod Wood indicated that this would be ok because it is not a year of certification.

An Intent to Cut was signed for Millard Davis.

The DES sent another notification concerning the cutting near the shore line on Upper Kimball Lake.
