Possible ways to spend the ARPA money were discussed:

Installing an electrical outlet in the corner of the town house to be used during elections.

Possibly purchasing a storage unit for highway/roads equipment. Alan will investigate the cost of a 40-foot unit.

Bill Briggs stated that the Fire Warden Deputies were approved. He will give a list to me for the town report.
