The town needs the A-12 form and financial reports to be filed with the town prior to the Mountain Mentors application to be tax exempt can be approved.

The town received a municipal roadway soils factsheet from DES

The intent to cut wood for Rotten Rock Enterprize is on hold, the WMNF insisted that they hold off.

Julie Hoyt has resigned from the planning board. I will take over the responsibility of uploading the minutes to the Selectmen's meetings. Jason will talk with Patrick about putting the minutes on the website to see if the website is ready again.

FEMA money for the May Storm may come to Carroll County soon. The town has spent \$57,793.72 so far. There are still some culverts that need to be replaced.

The town received information about an opportunity to join an organization for mutual aide for road agents. Alan will look it over and get back to the Selectmen.
